



NEW LONDON COMMUNITY SHUTTLE

Running half hour loops from 11am to 6pm with stops at the following locations:

- 1 New London's Juneteenth Celebration at The Hempsted Houses**
A day of speakers, family activities, music, dance and community festivities commemorating Juneteenth at one of New England's oldest dwellings. Event runs from 10am to 4pm.
- 2 Fort Trumbull State Park**
Open 10am to 5pm. Immerse yourself in an interactive history lesson at the visitor center (free on this day, normally \$6) or just walk the Fort and its ramparts for stunning views of the Thames River.
- 3 New London County Historical Society at Shaw Mansion**
Open 10am to 1pm. Founded in 1870, the New London County Historical Society is the oldest historical organization in eastern Connecticut.
- 4 Custom House Maritime Museum**
Open 10am to 5pm. Admission is Free! Telling the stories of the waterfront. Everyone receives 10% off in the Shop; as a bonus NLMS members receive 30% off!
- 5 Thames River Hop-on, Hop-off Harbor Cruise**
Take a \$5 harbor cruise via the water taxi to Fort Trumbull and Fort Griswold State Parks. To make a reservation scan the QR code or go to thamesriverheritagepark.org/boat-tours and enter promo code 2023CTOHD at checkout. Tickets may also be purchased on the boat.
- 6 Lyman Allyn Art Museum**
*Free admission to all on CT Open House Day. Explore special exhibition **Barkley L. Hendricks in New London**, exploring the role of place, community, and teaching in Hendricks' career, or admire the special microphotography images of bugs in **Small Wonders: Insects in Focus**. Family centric exploration guides are free to pick up to help young learners enjoy the museum.*
